

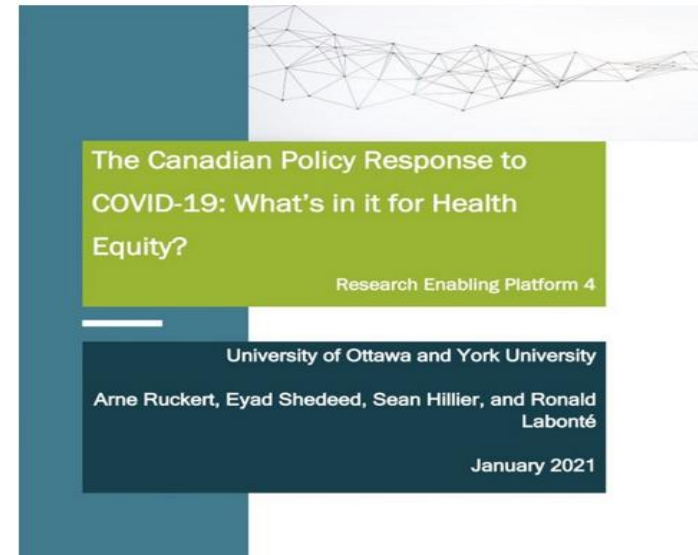

- Environmental scan of One Health preparedness in Brazil, Ecuador, Mexico and Rwanda

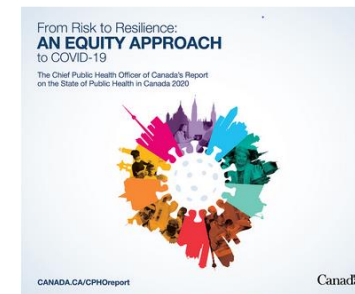
