Global 1HN Summer Institute 2021

The 2021 [Global One Health Network](#) (Global 1HN) Summer Institute will bring together students and professionals locally and internationally to explore One Health (OH) global governance of infectious diseases and antimicrobial resistance (AMR) with a topical focus on the global governance of SARS-CoV2. The 3-day course will offer in depth sessions on OH principles and provide knowledge and skills on how to operationalize the OH approach to improve the global governance of infectious diseases. Participants will engage through live, synchronous sessions, small group discussion and asynchronous self-paced components. The summer institute will provide an opportunity to network with fellow professionals in the clinical and research fields of infectious diseases.

The summer institute overall objectives include:

- Develop an in-depth understanding of OH principles and approaches
- Acquire knowledge about global health governance and global governance for health
- Develop familiarity with global governance response to the SARS-CoV2 pandemic
- Explore application of OH principles to the global governance of infectious diseases
- Understand the role of health inequities in global governance of infectious diseases
- Develop skills to assess global governance architecture from a OH perspective, and identify barriers and opportunities for OH implementation
- Reflect on ability to prepare governance structures for transition from emerging to endemic disease status for SARS-CoV2

Course Format: Participants should be prepared to commit 12 hours of interaction/ instruction over 3 days, with a mix of lecturing and discussion, group learning, and advance reading. Sessions will be taught in English and French (with simultaneous translation, and discussion groups offered in both languages).
